I am directed to address you on the subject noted above and to say that question regarding proper defence court cases before the Tribunals/Commissions etc. i.e. Punjab State Human Rights Commission, Central Administrative Tribunals, State Tax Tribunals, College Tribunals, State Transport Tribunals, State Disputes Redressal Commission, Debit Recovery Tribunal of any other such forms has been under consideration of the State Govt. for some time past. It has now been decided that the Law Office of the office of the Advocate General/Punjab will defend the cases before the Tribunals/Commissions. It has further been decided that where the Department feels that a particular case being important may be required to be defended by a Senior/Specialist counsel then they may seek the services of such counsel of their choice, with the prior approval of the Home Department.

2. This policy instructions will take immediate effect.
