No. G.S.R. 71/Const/Art. 309/Amd. (1)/91.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the President of India is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab Assistant District Attorneys, Grade-II (Class-III) Service Rules, 1989, namely:—

RULES

1. Short Title.—These rules may be called the Punjab Assistant District Attorneys, Grade-II (Class-III) (First Amendment) Service Rules, 1991.

2. In the Punjab Assistant District Attorneys, Grade-II (Class-III) Service Rules, 1989, in rule 7,—

(i) in sub-rule (1), for the existing clauses (a), (b) and (c), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:—

“(a) By direct appointment of persons who possess a degree of Bachelor of Laws (Professional Degree) of a recognised university or who are Barristers of England or Ireland or are members of Faculty of Advocates of Scotland and are eligible for being enrolled as an Advocate under the Advocates Act, 1961, and who have two years' experience of practice at the Bar.

(b) In case no suitable candidate is available by direct appointment, the Government shall make recruitment by transfer of persons already in service of the State Government possessing the requisite qualifications and experience specified for the post for direct appointment.”; and

(ii) sub-rule (2) shall be omitted.
